Description

Ring in 750/°° yellow gold (18 KT, owl hallmark) and platinum (mascaron head hallmark) with a beautiful volume typical of Tank rings from the 1940s. Very architectural, it has a signet ring volume with a checkerboard-shaped tray, set with diamonds, alternating two old-cut diamonds with two square pavings of old-cut diamonds also, grain-set. The two diamonds are enhanced compared to the pavings in two square setting boxes, giving volume to this tray. The square shape used on all the lines of the ring accentuates the very structured and architectural character of the whole, and its rectilinear and balanced design refers to Art Deco lines. Its general signet ring shape and its volume make it an ideal ring for both men and women. Total diamond weight estimated at approximately 1.40 carats Gross
