Found in India and Sri Lanka, it is often associated with local myths and shamanic beliefs.- Androctonus amoreuxi scorpion - (Case size: 12.5 × 4 × 6 cm) Also known as the "Tunisian scorpion", it is part of the genus Androctonus, whose name means "Man-killer" in ancient Greek. This species, widespread in North Africa and the Middle East, is a formidable predator and adapted to extreme
