18th Century, Italian Neoclassical Six Lacquered Wood Benches
Measurements: 4 benches: L 47 x 47 x H sitting 52; 2 benches: L 82 x 46,5 x H sitting 52
The four small benches and the two big benches were made in Italy (Turin) in the neoclassical era, towards the end of the eighteenth century. The structure is in wood lacquered in ochre yellow, blue sugar paper and white. All seats have a carving that draws frames in relief that create decoration and movement to the band under the seat. The legs originate with a flattened double-sphere element from which departs the fluted leg and truncated cone upside down. They are finished on the four sides and therefore can be placed in the center of environments without necessarily having to be leaned against the walls. It is a very rare set to find
