This patinated bronze sculpture faithfully depicts a standing horse, inspired by an iconic work by Edgar Degas (1834-1917), a major figure of Impressionism. Based on the original wax model held at the Musée d'Orsay, this piece captures the elegance and muscular tension of the horse in a posture of apparent calm. A work that embodies Degas's genius for movement and capturing the frozen moment. The horse is depicted standing in a stable and elegant position: its front legs anchored, its hind legs slightly offset, and its head turned to the left with striking nobility. This expressive style, with forms that are both supple and structured, is typical of Degas's exploration of balance and movement. Cast by the renowned Ébano foundry in Barcelona, this limited edition consists of only 48 pieces worldwide. No. 1/48,
