Equally interesting, they use camel hair or colored sheep wool for the background. This type of Persian rug has a longer lifespan than others, making them perfect rugs for long hallways. Thanks to the production of a durable wool pile and the Turkish knots used, these rugs are hard to beat. Their beautiful and unique design with colored camel hair in the background combines magnificently with any type of furniture. The figures are repeated hexagons, sometimes interspersed with diamonds.
