Lamp in shape of a nave with a closed reservoir, made of thick iron, burning on open flame, used in mines, but also at home, lock of hatch above in shape of a rooster, forged and cut. Overhanging finger grip, long pointed hook for fixing in wood. Mining lamp, 18-19th century, from Cévennes, the figure of rooster is a reminder to be vigilant: the color of flame indicates the possible presence of dangerous gases.... Elaborate folk art object, of good quality.... Condition: discovery, good, no holes or dents, no flaw, To be polished, it will be superb. Dimensions: H: 45cm x 14cm x 10cm, weight: 520gr.
