Jacques Sokol - Provence Landscape



Description

This captivating post-impressionist oil painting by Jacques Sokol, created in 1965, beautifully depicts the Provençal countryside with a mountain in the background. Sokol's masterful use of earthy tones--golden yellows, ochres, deep greens, and warm rust hues--captures the warmth and character of the Mediterranean landscape. His bold brushstrokes and thick impasto technique add striking texture and depth, bringing movement and life to the scene. The soft blues and muted grays of the sky contrast harmoniously with the vibrant terrain, evoking a serene yet dynamic atmosphere. Encased in an ornate 19th-century gilded frame, this piece exemplifies Sokol's distinctive impressionistic approach during this period. on September 3, 1933, in Loches (Indre-et-Loire, France), he developed his artistic skills through self-taught training, first under the guidance of his father and later with Mathurin Méheut from 1947. In 1960, he settled in Senlis (Oise) while balancing his military career in the air force with his passion for painting. A regular participant in the Salon des Artistes Français, he exhibited widely in France and abroad, gaining recognition for his evocative landscapes. His work evolved from abstract compositions to impressionism, before adopting a darker, more somber aesthetic towards the end of his life. Sokol's paintings celebrate the landscapes of Brittany, Provence, Auvergne, and Oise, capturing their unique atmosphere with vivid colors and textured brushwork. He passed away on January 23, 2023, in Nogent-sur-Oise at the age of 89, leaving behind a rich legacy of expressive and atmospheric landscape art. Artist: Jacques Sokol (1933-2023).
