Reclining female figure in bronze, called "Nympe à la Coquille", after an Antique kept at the Louvre Museum. Italy, first half of the 18th century. Later fixed on a base at the end of the 19th or beginning of the 20th century. Total dimensions: Height 11.5 cm Width 15.7 cm Depth 9 cm The Antique sculpture is now kept at the Louvre

It was very widely disseminated during the 17th and 18th centuries through numerous bronzes and engravings (cf. Pour l'Amour de l'Antique...).
