## Description

Jean-Frédéric Schall (1752-1825) was an 18th-century painter known for his Rococo-inspired genre scenes. He enjoyed depicting moments of elegant sociability, where music, dance, and conversation played a central role. This painting depicts a seduction scene in a refined interior. The man, leaning on the harpsichord, leans toward one of the two young women and kisses her hand in a gallant gesture. The young woman, standing, appears charmed, while the other female figure remains focused on the music. Here, the music becomes a pretext for proximity and dialogue between the characters. The care given to the textures, the balance of the composition, and the expression of the figures recall the codes of gallant painting. This work by Schall is fully in keeping with the 18th-century
