



## Orange Tree Pot Late 17th - Early 18th Century



## Description

Imposing orange tree pot in white and blue earthenware from the Center of France from the end of the 17th or very beginning of the 18th century, decorated with arabesques and foliage. The handles simulate rope. The model is interesting for its size (diam: 38 cm - Height: 34 cm - width: 43 cm) and for the rarity of its decoration. Restorations and accidents visible on the photos in the lower part of the orange tree pot. Chips Period End of the 17th - beginning of the 18th century Delivery at the buyer's expense.
