This lantern is offered in the 1908 catalog of the Maison de la Bonne Presse, created by Georges-Michel COISSAC: "Device "Bonne Presse" No. 1 recommended to lecturers. It is an "elegant and solid device, with a rich body...". It consists of a body in thick Russian sheet metal with a door on both sides and a double rear door topped with an openwork conical dome with a frieze chimney. The front is entirely in varnished copper with a square and very thick spring-loaded plate and counterplate allowing the introduction of various film holders
