Description

- Wall lamp consisting of a gilt bronze support and an allegorical figure of Renown in patinated bronze, Empire style work circa 1860. - This wall lamp consists of a gilt bronze support; a wall part decorated at its ends with scrolled stems, a structure in the form of a gilt bronze scroll adorned with numerous floral motifs (foliage bases, flowers, palmettes). It is on the latter that stands on a globe, a winged female allegorical figure in patinated bronze draped in the antique style, a universal renown. This sculpture holds at arm's length, like a caryatid, a gilt bronze plant crown serving as a support for three cornucopia-shaped light arms. The latter are finely chiseled with plant motifs as well. - This candelabra is distinguished by the research into material effects with a variation in finishing
