



Workshop Plaster Cast By Ch. Filleul Representing A Couple In Antique 20th Century



Description

This 20th century studio plaster cast was made by Charles Filleul. It is probably preparatory work for a statue of a public commission, we can still see the traces of modeling. For the condition, note that the work was broken and glued back together, we report cracks and gaps, traces of wear. However, the whole has a lot of allure. Charles Filleul (1853-1907), French sculptor of busts and figures, student of Cavelier and A. Millet, member of the French Artists, he obtained an honorable mention in 1887.
