Description

Large gilt and lacquered metal table lamp with a spray of silver-plated and lacquered wisteria flowers, by Hans Kögl. Probably made by Maison Jansen in the 1960s and 1970s. The lamp is in very good condition and the wiring has been overhauled. Height (without shade): 56 cm. Width: 35 cm. Kögl often drew inspiration from natural forms such as wheat sheaves, Florentine flowers, and wisteria to design sculptural lighting fixtures, tables, and various decorative objects. Kögl's vintage gilt-metal lamps and sophisticated table bases capture nature in a way that goes beyond simple imitation of life--the leaves and other plants in copper and gold-plated, free-spirited and elegantly handcrafted works require a double take to fully appreciate the designer's profound attention to detail.
