Beautiful richly carved model resting on a central console foot, decorated with acanthus leaves and rows of piastres, the belt carved with interlacing. It is topped with a gray Sainte Anne marble. Parisian work from the Louis XVI period - late 18th century to be compared to the productions of Jacob. Beautiful sculpture with elegant proportions, particularly this central console foot, our console is suitable for an entrance or a dining room (the green color recalls that of the dining room of the Camondo hotel). Beautiful charming object from the 18th century, ideal for a country house or a city apartment. Very good general condition, sound structure and in good condition, small restorations.
