Lost wax edition cast, signed on the terrace by Roger Godchaux, intaglio marked Susse Frères éditeurs in Paris with the stamp and noted cire perdue. The lioness walks and turns her head to the left. We are immediately caught by her gaze and her gait so well represented by the artist. 13.5x25.5cm Very good condition and superb original patina.
