Engraved flat breech tail.Brass front sight.Round-bodied lock, finely engraved with foliage and chased. Gooseneck hounds and engraved bassoon cover.Cut-out brass counterplate with repoussé decoration illustrating a hunting scene on foot.Brass trigger guard, decorated en suite.Brass cap with long tail, half-round decoration and strong cap nail.Walnut frame, lightly carved with filigree remains. Brass thumb pieces.Wooden ramrod.This pistol is complete, with a small missing frame. The lock operation needs to be revised.Reference:
