### Description

Doulton Lambeth stoneware teapot with silver mounts, England, 1880 This rare Doulton Lambeth teapot, crafted in 1880, showcases the superb artistry of the celebrated English stoneware manufactory. Made from finely moulded stoneware, the teapot is richly decorated with a repeating diamond pattern of applied beading and stylised foliate motifs. The vivid cobalt blue, olive green, and ochre glazes are typical of the period's Art Pottery movement, emphasising naturalistic colours and tactile surfaces. Adding refinement to the design, the lid and spout mounts are crafted from sterling silver by John Grinsell & Sons, fully hallmarked for Birmingham, 1880. The silver lid mount is hinged and fitted to a domed ceramic cover adorned with matching floral decoration. The overall design

reflects the influence of the Aesthetic Movement, combining form, texture, and restrained colour to elevate a functional object into an artwork. Today, pieces such as this teapot are highly sought after by collectors of British Art Pottery and Victorian decorative arts, appreciated for their historical significance and artistic quality.

**Historical Background**Doulton Lambeth, founded in London in the early 19th century, became renowned for its pioneering use of salt-glazed stoneware and for the exceptional skill of its artists. By the 1860s, the company had embraced the Art Pottery movement, producing finely decorated wares that merged utility with artistic expression. Their collaborations with leading silversmiths, such as John Grinsell & Sons, added further prestige to their work.
