Masonic sword with flamboyant blade and Masonic attributes, 19th century, punched at the heel of the blade. Brass mount decorated with Masonic attributes with a trefoil pommel with a delta on one side and a starry delta on the other, see the details of the attributes in the photos. Fuse with acacia branch and vertical lines. Straight quillon with trowel and mallet, compass and square with an escutcheon with entwined hands on one side. Other side compass and delta, plumb line, escutcheon identical to the other side. Flat blade with 2 flamboyant-type edges with its tie and punch at the heel. Length: 89 cm Length of the blade: 75 cm Width of the blade at the heel: 1.8 cm Good condition of conservation and use, in its own juice and patina, see the details in the photos.
