


1732 - Theaters And Pamphlets By Guillaume Bougeant, Breton Priest

Volume bringing together three writings by Guillaume Bougeant, a Jesuit priest born in Quimper, printed in 1732. Format in-12 (16 x 10 cm) Each piece is preceded by a frontispiece, an engraving. ? Two Comedies printed in The Hague: - The Woman Doctor, or Theology Fallen into Distaff. Comedy. 150 pages. - The Uncovered Saint, or The Bankruptcy of Miracle Merchants. Comedy. 144 pages. ? A pamphlet: Harlequin, Esprit Folet. Comedy. 68 pages. (Without mention of printer). Note: some marginal tears on a few pages of the pamphlet, not affecting the text. Scattered foxing due to time. Nice collection of writings against the Jansenists. These plays were very successful upon their release.
