



Earrings, Sapphire, Gold And Silver.



Description

These earrings are called sleepers. Mounted in gold and silver, they are each adorned with two white sapphires, superimposed, of different dimensions and cut with facets. They sparkle with a thousand lights and are endowed with the charm of 19th century jewelry. They are kept in a case which is old. They bear the gold control hallmark which is an eagle's head from 1838, then a hallmark that we have not identified as well as a Master hallmark. The diameter of the large stone is 4 mm and the smallest 2 mm. Period late 19th century 480 EUR
