Jean-Marie CAMUS (1877-1955)*. "Bust of a pensive child". Sculpture in gilt and patinated bronze. Early 20th century. The head and gaze turned to the left with a mischievous air, full, curly hair. The child's bust overflows onto the marble base. Signed and dated 1903. Stamp of the founder AG* Numbered 52 D. Height 40cm W 30cm D 22cm *Jean-Marie CAMUS (1877-1955). Born in Clermont-Ferrand on November 12, 1877 - Died in Paris on June 16, 1955 Student of the Ecole Nationale des Beaux-Arts, student of Barrias and Coutan. Knight of the Legion of Honor. He exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français in Paris from 1900 and received a gold medal "out of competition" in 1931. *Arthur Goldscheider is the son of the Austrian entrepreneur, Friedrich Goldscheider,
