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production limited to the 18th and early 19th centuries. These pots accompanied coffee or tea services, used to add a small amount of milk or cream to hot drinks. Their small size was suitable for individual services (solitaires, Tête à Tête or travel kits). Parisian manufacturers, such as Sèvres, produced these pots in various sizes, but the smaller formats were less common.
