Coat of arms

of the House of Emperor Napoleon III (1808/1873). Marks: "Christofle", "61" master goldsmith's hallmark.

Note: Charles Christofle (1805-1863), a jeweler, founded the company in 1830 and registered his hallmark in 1832.

In 1851,

Emperor Napoleon III commissioned Christofle to produce official Empire dinner services.

Its titles of King's Goldsmith and Emperor's Supplier enabled the company, which had become
