Trained at the Royal Catalan Academy of Fine Arts of Sant Jordi under masters such as Francisco Ribera Gómez, Josep Puigdengolas Barrella and Luisa Granero Sierra, he developed an exceptional mastery of the human and animal figure in bronze. His talent and contribution to the arts were recognized by his appointment as a Knight of the National Order of Merit in France. His work, exhibited widely, demonstrates a profound artistic sensitivity and virtuoso technique.
