Description

This original work, attributed to Pierre Commarmond, was also created for the 1933 edition of the Paris Fair. Executed in gouache under glass, it is a unique piece, conceived as a preparatory model for one of the most visually audacious posters of the time. The scene highlights a bundle of electrical cables converging towards a focal point, guided by a bright red mast. It is a stylized and powerful vision of modernity: Paris becomes the center of a global energy and communications network, celebrating electrification, technological progress, and connectivity between nations. Its taut graphics, bold colors, and radical treatment of perspective place this work at the heart of the industrial Art Deco aesthetic, both functional and symbolic.
