Elegance, purity of lines and craftsmanship excellence define this rare vest chain forming a sautoir, signed Cartier, created during the Art Deco period, towards the end of the 1930s. Crafted in 18-carat yellow gold (750?), this collector's item features a marine "anchor chain" link of great finesse, both understated and sophisticated. It bears the master mark of Marcel-François Renard, a renowned Parisian goldsmith, established at 80 rue de Turenne in Paris, active since 1938.
