


Treatise Of Primrose On The Vulgar Errors Of Medicine

First edition of the French translation by Jean de Rostagny of the treatise on the Common Errors of Medicine by the Scottish physician James Primerose. The original appeared in 1639 under the title De vulgi erroribus in medicina. This work is one of the witnesses to the battle waged by certain practitioners against folk medicine, in opposition to learned medicine, which was widespread in the 17th and 18th centuries. The treatise, with additions by Jean de Rostagny, is composed of 4 books: On Physicians - On Errors Concerning
