The Jeanselme firm A century-old dynasty of cabinetmakers, they set up a seating factory during the Restoration. Thanks to their prosperity, they acquired the Jacob firm in 1847. Offering top-quality products, this firm supplied the Garde-Meubles of Louis Philippe and later Napoleon III. Condition report: still in its original upholstery, covered with Tiger-style silk velvet from Bevilacqua.
