




Le Vermicelier (italian Pasta Maker) - 18th Century

Original steel engraving with burin and watermarked laid paper. From the Encyclopédie méthodique, known as "PANCKOUKE" published in 1782 by Charles-Joseph PANCKOUKE, then by his widow. Engraved by BENARD Robert, (French - 1734/??). The VERMICELIER is the manufacturer of fresh pasta that Italians love. It is the smallest pasta from Italy. The name "vermicelli" comes from its resemblance to the small whitish worms. Hand-watercolored.
