Original steel engraving with burin and watermarked laid paper. From the Encyclopédie méthodique, known as "PANCKOUKE" published in 1782 by Charles-Joseph PANCKOUKE, then by his widow. Engraved by BENARD Robert, (French - 1734/??). The VERMICELIER is the manufacturer of fresh pasta that Italians love. It is the smallest pasta from Italy. The name "vermicelli" comes from its resemblance to the small whitish worms.
