Alexis Boissonnet : anthropomorphic jug in stoneware glazed in shades of pink and green. The base of the jug features a male face with symbolist influence. The handle is shaped like gnarled branch. Signed to the base. Alexis Boissonnet (1879 - 1956), a noted ceramist based in Saint Vallier, Drôme. Commended at the Paris Exposition Universelle in 1900. In 1902, he represented the École de Nancy at the Universal Exhibition in Turin. Height 23cm Width 12cm Small nick to the base of the jug - see our photos.
