And Christ places his right hand on the top of his mother's bust. Moving testimony of a Virgin in majesty. She is no longer seated on her throne but standing and the child is no longer on her knees but carried on her arm. Work from southern France. End of the Gothic period. Around 1500. 48cm high It is a favorite for me, I discovered it in a very heterogeneous collection. It is the first work that I saw in the house. I could only buy it to offer it to you.
