Anthropomorphic mask with a grimacing face - Nepal, mid-hills, 19th-early 20th century
Enigmatic face with an apparent smile. On the forehead are engraved a Swastika, a trishula and a petaled flower. In Nepal, geographically and culturally influenced by Buddhist Tibet and Hindu India, it is common to see Buddhist and Hindu symbols mixed in folk art.
