JAPAN - Edo Period (1603-1868) Samurai Yari Spear. Finely burgauté wooden shaft, the last quarter decorated with a braided and gilded rope sabot, two copper rings. Straight "Ho" spear blade of triangular section, double-edged and red lacquered throat, it is protected by a saya in textured lacquered wood (very uneven). At the other end a black lacquered metal cap "Hirumaki" to protect the shaft from damage by contact with the ground. Dimensions: 240 x 20.5 x 3 cm. Blade length: 106.5 cm. Sold with the base. Dimensions with the base: 240 x 20 x 18 cm.
