Contemporary uniform bindings of full glazed and marbled hazelnut calf, triple gilt fillet framing the covers, smooth spines decorated with a double gilt framing fillet, double gilt fillets, gilt roulettes, gilt fleurons, gilt circles, mahogany morocco title pieces, gilt title, gilt volume number on ebony background, gilt palette at the foot, gilt fillet on the cuts, marbled edges. Rare collection comprising 5 works by Nicole; here bound in 12 volumes. Set - in decorative and uniform bindings of the time - containing each of the works by Pierre Nicole published under the title of Instructions théologiques et morales. The 5 (out of 5) volumes containing his Moral Reflections were added here at the time. "Pierre Nicole has here supported the unity and the principal misguided dogmas, he has clarified morality against those who alter its purity, discovered the illusions of false piety and has given sure and incontestable rules and principles of true piety." Minor worm work affecting the upper margin of a few leaves of one of the volumes. Another has a more substantial gallery, with, at most, the loss of two letters on three lines on a few leaves.
