Description: Charming genre scene in a tavern, where several characters in 17th-century costume laugh, drink and chat around a table. On the left, a draughtsman sketches the scene, reinforcing the *mise en abyme* typical of the Flemish tradition. The narrative and expressive treatment, the warm light and the picturesque details directly evoke the works of David Teniers the Younger or Adriaen van Ostade.
