Pair of bronze sculptures - "Going Fishing"

Elegant pair of bronze sculptures with brown patina representing a man and a woman, subtly illustrating the moment of going fishing. Each piece depicts a fisherman in traditional dress, capturing the essence of maritime life with great attention to detail. The expressions of the figures, the texture of the clothing and the fishing accessories are rendered with striking realism, testifying to the exceptional skill of the sculptor. The bronzes bear the stamp "Susse Frères", a famous Parisian foundry active since the 19th century, renowned for the quality of its art castings. This stamp guarantees a high-quality execution, faithful to the artist's intentions.

Although the artist is not explicitly identified on the pieces, the style and subject matter suggest a
