Ottoman flintlock rifle called tüfek shishana - Ottoman Turkey, 18th-19th century. Collectors and museums call this type of rifle tüfek (it is simply the Turkish word for rifle) and shishana refers to short rifles. Lock with gold damascened morlaque. Functional mechanism. Barrel forged from beautiful Damascus steel. Stock decorated with silver-gilt elements set with red coral cabochons. Stock covered with green velvet. Bone butt plate. Unfortunately the wooden stock is cut after the lock. The weapon still stands but this causes play and would require professional restoration.
