Let us simply say that this man, whose name alone evokes the Action Française and ultra-nationalism, was an intellectual, writer, critic, journalist and ideologue who played an important role within the right and the extreme right in France under the Third Republic. This very beautiful, almost photographic portrait, whose signature has not been deciphered, represents him still young, at just over 40 years old. Originally from Martigues near Marseille, he
