Rare large painting by Cesar Alexandre FORMENTI (1874-1944) depicting a view of the sea from the "Pedra do Arpoador", Arpoador Rock in Rio de Janeiro, BrazilArpoador is a residential neighborhood in the city of Rio de Janeiro, located on the seafront, where the Ipanema and Copacabana neighborhoods meet. It takes its name from the Pedra do Arpoador, a rocky promontory that marks the beginning of Ipanema Beach. The name of this neighborhood comes from the fishing populations originally living there and who practiced harpoon fishing from the promontory.
