Important pinnacle of oak and walnut woodwork carved in the mass. Very beautiful and deep sculpture in the shape of a fire pot, with draperies on the belly and an explosion of flowers carved in high relief. It is most certainly a piece of carved wood which must have decorated the top of a woodwork or an interior chapel. It was based on a half disc in light oak ensuring stability, but it can be removed to hang it on the wall. Period 18th century. Heavy set, approximately 15 to 20 kg. Delivery by carrier, 100 euros in France, 200 euros in the EU and 500 euros rest of the world.
