Gogo or Afternoon Ca.1970 Beautiful impression with fresh colors and embossing effects on the eyelid and collar. Soft handling creases in the outer edges. Iwata Sentaro was born in Kurofune-cho, Asakusa-ku, Tokyo (now Kotobuki, Taito-ku, Tokyo). He started in Kyoto as a disciple of Kikuchi Keigetsu, a Japanese painter. Back in Tokyo in 1919 he became the protégé of Hakubunkan and produced illustrations for its magazine "Kodan Magazine". then for "Bungei Club". At this time, around 1920, he became a disciple of Ito Shinsui. In 1961 he was rewarded for his work and received the medal with purple ribbon
