Refined alternation of midnight blue and ivory highlighting the contours of the decoration. Design: The rug features an elegant central floral medallion on a red background, framed by a profusion of symmetrical bouquets in a style typical of Sarouk from the 1920s and 1930s. The turquoise blue spandrels host dense stylized vegetation, highlighted by a richly drawn triple border. Each floral motif, meticulously executed, demonstrates exceptional craftsmanship. Sarouk rugs from this period were particularly sought after in Western markets, as reflected in the fineness of the knotting, the delicate palette and the remarkable level of detail.
