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used...!With chiseling and small details added
(the tips of the shoes...!)...In very good condition,
just wear and manufacturing defects...Dirt or lack
of color on the hair...And a small chip at the base
(see photo)...But it's anecdotal...!It must have
been put outside because I cleaned a lot of traces
of limestone on the reliefs...And enamel wear on
one hand...Moreover the hands which are hidden
under the folds of the tunic...For me it may be a
monk or a eunuch...!I don't know everything yet
on the subject but as soon as I have information I
will note it...An astonishing subject...!We can still
see a few mini twigs inside... Dirt or something
else?... I have other photos and I can easily take
