Chiseled silver lunula box, with a flat bottom, the domed lid is chiseled with a corolla of aquatic plant leaves. It is topped with a cross. Traces of gilding inside. 950/1000 silver, Minerva hallmarks Master Goldsmith Hallmark: Désir et Arquiche, goldsmiths, Lyon around 1850
Inner diameter: 7.2 cm
Outer diameter: 7.9 cm
Height of the lunula location (without the lid): 2.4 cm
Height with the summit cross: 6.3 cm
Weight: 81 gr
Very good condition / without shocks, deformations or scratches / The cross is later.
This box can be suitable for lunulas of different diameters and thicknesses.
