Jean-Paul Jappé, born in Lorient in 1936, followed artistic training at the École des Beaux-Arts in Quimper where he practiced ceramics in the course of Pierre Toulhoat. Invited by his teacher with whom he maintained ties of friendship, he developed some original ceramics in the workshops of the Keraluc factory. Subsequently, he completed his training in Paris at the Académie Charpentier then at the École des Métiers d'Art. Returning to Lorient,
