Description

1. Description of the work: This bust in composite materials represents a young woman with her face turned towards the sky, expressing a dreamy or contemplative posture. The soft lines of the sculpture, as well as the flowing hair blending into the base, evoke a harmony between the human and the natural. The green patina reinforces the dreamlike and timeless aspect of the work. 2. Artistic trends: The work is part of the Symbolist movement with an Art Nouveau influence, notably through its organic forms and poetic expressiveness. The fluid style also evokes a certain kinship with the classical idealization of the female face. 3.
