Description

This finely crafted gilt bronze garniture is a remarkable example of Neo-Baroque goldsmithing and decorative art. It is composed of several elements, including a large vase and richly decorated ewers. The central element of the garniture features an inverted helmet shape, evoking heraldry and military art. Winged and fantastical figures, probably chimeras or griffins, adorn the handles and upper parts of the objects, reinforcing the majestic character of the composition. The handles are worked with elegant curves and sophisticated scrolls, volutes, and arabesques typical of the Rococo and Louis XV styles. The bodies of the vases feature highly detailed relief decorations, with floral and foliate motifs as well as finely crafted coats of arms or cartouches. Each piece rests on a griotte marble
