Quin???Julien Tavernier 1923Signed on the back on the canvas:"SpringJulien Tavernier 1923Beautiful oil on canvas depicting spring, two young women ambling in the grass surrounded by cherry trees watching a child playing with a goat; under the discreet and mischievous eye of a faun.Julien Louis Tavernier was born on August 22, 1879 in Paris and is the son of Alexandre Marie Tavernier, a fabric manufacturer, and Blanche Hornorine Hutinet.He was a student of Léon Bonnat, and exhibited at the Salon from 1908, then became a member of the Society of French Artists.In 1909, he received a medal of honor, a silver medal in 1925 accompanied by the
